

The CSA Hermitage was built in 1982 to commemorate the twenty-fifth anniversary of establishing the Sisters of Charity of St. Augustine Motherhouse on the grounds in Richfield, Ohio.

The small cabin, designed to be harmonious with the environment, was built overlooking a pond. It is secluded yet within walking distance of the Motherhouse. It is quiet and a perfect place for prayer or an individual retreat. The CSA Hermitage is equipped with a twin bed, table and chair, a Crucifix and Bible. The building is heated and has a small kitchenette. Sheets and towels are provided.

The Hermitage offers these possibilities:

- ♦ A Poustinia Day for fasting and prayer
- ♦ One or more days of retreat in solitude
- A chapel with daily Mass, library, and dining room for optional meals are located in the main building within easy walking distance
- Quiet walks on the grounds

It is available from April 1 until Thanksgiving, depending on the weather. There is no set fee; donation should be according to your means. The suggested amount is \$15-20 per day. (Cash or check only)
